Smithville Jamboree Parade Rules & Regulations

ABSOLUTELY NO CANDY OR ANY ITEMS CAN BE THROWN FROM PARADE ENTRY,

You may however walk along side the entry and hand out candy & etc.

- 1. You must be registered and in line no later than 10 am
- 2. Consumption of alcoholic beverages by drivers or any participants before or during the parade is strictly forbidden. If caught drinking, you will be escorted from parade & this will jeopardize future parade participation.
- 3. Autos & large vehicles must be driven by a licensed driver. Small vehicles (mini bikes, small tractors, go-carts, etc.) mu be operated by a person 12 yrs. of age or older. All pets must be on leashes.
- 4. Parade participants are not permitted to leave vehicles to demonstrate in any street or to stop or slow the forward movement of the parade in any way.
- 5. When disbanding on N.W. 6th. Street, units shall not block the flow of traffic for participants following behind them.
- 6. All horse riders MUST KEEP CONTROL OF THEIR HORSE AT ALL TIMES. If a horse becomes unruly, you mu leave the parade route.
